Winning two rounds should put us in the Top 10 this early in the season. Now all we have to do is stay consistent and that should keep us in the top,” said Parker.

A combination of good reaction times and a consistent car led to the successful day, until a red light in the third round. Parker and the team have seven races left before the NHRA Junior Drag Racing League Eastern Conference Finals in Bristol, Tennessee. In order to qualify for an entry to the ECF’s, they must place in the Top 9 at Summit Motorsports Park.

“One of our major goals for the season is to make it to Bristol. We have to be in the top 9 by the middle of July, but I think we can do it. Competing at the Eastern Conference Finals is something that only the best Junior Dragster drivers in the eastern half of the country get to do. I think that this is our year to prove that we are a part of that group,” claimed the Berlin Heights, Ohio-based driver.
